



IMPORTANT NOTICE

TO PERSONS IN CHARGE OF LAUNCHED CRAFT

FILEY COBLE LANDING

You are using a facility owned by this authority and are recommended to take note of the following:

1. You are required to hold third party insurance cover to a minimum liability of £1 million.
2. You should have on board a marine VHF radio and monitor channels 16 and 67.
3. You should have on board flares and suitable lifejackets for all onboard (Please note the RNLI advise that “Lifejackets are useless if not worn”)
4. Check the weather forecast and observe the state of the sea before attempting to launch. Be sure your vessel is capable of handling the conditions that will be encountered during your trip.
5. Ensure the safety strop/chain is connected when towing the trailer on the Coble Landing. Trailers must not be left on the Coble Landing or where they may obstruct the launching and recovery of other boats.
6. Please ensure that your vessel is handled in a competent manner and that you avoid taking unnecessary risks.
When close to the beach proceed at a slow speed.
Do not use an engine/motor near to people in the water.
