

# **SCARBOROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **HARBOUR ACT 1964** **SCARBOROUGH HARBOUR DUES AND CHARGES** **Effective as from the 1st day of April 2010**

***All dues payable within 24 hours of entry or demand. Failure to comply may result in on-cost charges for administration. All calculations of overall length will be inclusive of fixtures and fittings.***

All measurements will be to the nearest highest 0.10 metre.

### **Harbour Dues**

Annual dues inclusive of slipway dues and the provision of drinking water, per square metre £23.80

Annual dues cover the year 1 April to 31 March

When ascertaining the size of the boat, the maximum length and breadth will be inclusive of fittings such as fixed bowsprit, pulpit, fixed outboard motor and rubbing stake, working to 2 decimal places.

Licensed Vessels - per metre per year 5% reduction on annual rate

### **Locally Licensed Small Passenger Vessels**

Passenger Dues for Vessels Carrying Not More than 12 passengers (Fishing Parties) in Addition to Harbour Dues

All licensed vessels:

Vessels licensed to carry not more than 4 passengers	£127.10 (Full year)
Vessels licensed to carry not more than 8 passengers	£254.30 (Full year)
Vessels licensed to carry not more than 12 passengers	£443.00 (Full year)

Vessels licensed to carry not more than 12 passengers - bona fide fisherman *	10% reduction on above rates

MCA licensed passenger vessels with over 12 passengers-per passenger	£26.60

\* A bona fide fisherman is a person whose principal occupation is that of fishing commercially and whose catch is landed on the Scarborough Fish Market and on which fish landing dues are levied.

Passenger vessels (carrying more than 12 passengers) Compounded Dues:-  
(Includes Harbour Dues and Charges) (i.e. D.T.I. Loadline exemption holders)  
Rates subject to negotiation, depending on number of passengers.

**Electric Charges –**

Use of power point – per day or part thereof	£9.40

Use of North Wharf electricity supply for shore power to fishing vessels per day or pro rata £26.90

Pontoon electricity – to be charged at actual cost of electricity consumed plus an administrative charge of 10% of the consumption

#### IV Rates for use of Harbour Premises

**Slipway:** Vessels using harbour slipways and flats for the purpose of cleaning or repairs.

1 April to 30 September per metre of length per day or part £0.98

1 October to 31 March per metre of length per day or part £0.35

Daily Rate for Launch, including harbour dues (but excluding car parking) £11.23

Where a boat is launched and removed during one tide, only one charge will be made.

Annual rate for unlimited number of launches £245.20

**Grid Blocks:** (advance booking will be acceptable only with advance non-returnable payment) per day or part thereof

Vessels not exceeding 10 metres length overall £11.90

Vessels between 10 metres and 20 metres length overall £17.70

Vessels exceeding 20 metres length overall £24.80

**Ground Rates** for any boat, boat trailer or cradle left on any wharf, pier or slipway top for laying up, cleaning or repair.

Per square metre of space occupied per week £8.20

Proportional charge per day or part thereof will apply. No boat, trailer or cradle shall be left without permission.

Where a boat having an assigned berth is to be placed in the harbour a period not exceeding 24 hours will be allowed before the ground rate charges apply provided that prior permission regarding the positioning of the boat or trailer has been obtained.

For the use of the North Wharf for fitting out or alteration or repair of fishing vessels. By prior arrangement only and at the discretion of the Borough Harbour Master and with written consent.

Per square metre of space occupied per week. £2.90

Proportional charge per day or part thereof will apply

For the use of any space on any wharf pier or slipway for any purpose not otherwise specified in the schedule or the subject of a special rental agreement.

Per square metre of space occupied per week. £8.20  
Proportional charge per day or part thereof will apply.
