HARBOUR ACT 1964 WHITBY HARBOUR DUES AND CHARGES Effective as from the 1st day of April 2010

All dues payable within 24 hours of entry or demand. Failure to comply may result in on-cost charges for administration. All calculations of overall length will be inclusive of fixtures and fittings.

All measurements will be to the nearest highest 0.10 metre.

Harbour Dues:

Annual dues cover the year 1 April to 31 March
Plus 25% for multi-hulled craft over 3 metres beam.

* A bona fide fisherman is a person whose principal occupation is that of fishing commercially and whose catch is landed on the Whitby Fish Market and on which fish landing dues are levied.

Upper harbour development berthing and mooring fees

Plus 25% for multi-hulled craft over 3 metres beam except that any multi-hulled vessel with a beam in excess of 4.5 metres will occupy only one berth and be charged at double the mooring fee and harbour dues.

5% reduction will apply to berthing fees for licensed vessels

For the period 1st April to 31st October:-

West Side - Single Berths

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £117.50 (min £895.10)

Main Pontoon:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £78.30 (min £713.80)

Church Street and East Side Pontoon Moorings:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £70.70 (min £648.90)

Drying Pontoon:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £51.50 (min £359.50)

For the period 1st November to 31st March:-

West Side - Single Berths

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £17.20 (min £132.10)

Main Pontoon:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £11.50 (min £104.80)

Church Street and East Side Pontoon Moorings:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £9.20 (min £83.50)

Drying Pontoon:

- per metre of overall length including fixtures and fittings £6.80 (min £47.20)

Storage of Craft

For the storage of craft during the period 1st November to 31st March -
per metre of overall length per week £1.20 (min £7.00)

For the storage of craft during the period 1 April to 31 October –
Per metre of overall length per week – at Harbour Master's discretion £2.40 (min £14.00)

Marina/Pontoon Electricity Supply – available in denominations of £1, £5 and £10

Use of power point – Fish Quay / New Quay Road
