HARBOUR ACT 1964
WHITBY HARBOUR DUES AND CHARGES
Effective from 1st Day of April 2010

All dues payable within 24 hours of entry or demand. Failure to comply may result in on-cost charges for administration. All calculations for overall length will be inclusive of fixtures and fittings.

All measurements will be to the nearest highest 0.10 metre.

Private Motorboats, Yachts, Pleasureboats and Houseboats

(All vessels must display a name) Annual dues cover the year 1 April to 31 March
Plus 25% for multi-hulled craft over 3 metres beam.

- Per month (per metre of overall length) £15.00
(only in exceptional circumstances and at the Harbour Masters discretion)

Visiting Craft

(NB Maximum length of stay for visiting pleasure craft - 14 days)

Where no permanent mooring has been allocated, per day or part thereof:

Per entry, per day (per metre of overall length) - £2.00
- (min 8 metres) £16.00

Visitors charges for non-pontoon mooring - 25% discount on above rate

Note: The above visitor charges also apply in those instances where the cargo berth area is used, at the discretion of the Harbour Master or his Deputy.

Marina Pontoon Electricity Supply Tokens available in denominations of £1, £5 and £10

Pump Out Facilities £8.68

Educational and Charitable Trust organisations Harbour Dues, block fee p.a. £244.60

Marina Users Car Park: - Bona fide visitors and slipway launches only. Car parking subject to availability of space at the discretion of the Harbour Master - Daily Charge:- £6.00 (inc. VAT)

Waiting List Application Fee £25.00 (inc. VAT)
Arrest Fee £60.00
Key Deposit for security gates £10.00 (inc. VAT)
