

# **SCARBOROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **HARBOUR ACT 1964** **SCARBOROUGH HARBOUR DUES AND CHARGES** **Effective as from the 1st day of April 2010**

***All dues payable within 24 hours of entry or demand. Failure to comply may result in on-cost charges for administration. All calculations of overall length will be inclusive of fixtures and fittings.***

### **Private Pleasure Craft**

When ascertaining the size of the boat, the maximum length and breadth will be inclusive of fittings such as fixed bowsprit, pulpit, fixed outboard motor and rubbing stake, working to 2 decimal places.

(NB Maximum length of stay for visiting pleasure craft - 14 days)

Where no permanent mooring has been allocated, per day or part thereof:

Per entry, per day (per metre of overall length)	2.00
- (min 8 metres)	£16.00

Visitors charges for non-pontoon mooring 25% discount on above rate

Note: Plus 25% for multi-hulled craft over 3 metres beam.

### **Movement of Vessels**

Daily Rate for Launch, including harbour dues (but excluding car parking) £11.23

Where a boat is launched and removed during one tide, only one charge will be made.

Annual rate for unlimited number of launches £245.20
